Knit with two strands of super bulky weight yarn held together, the Lugano Cowl is a quick project that is fun to wear or gift. With dramatic proportions & endless opportunities to customize, this cowl is a great addition to your Winter accessory collection.

PURVEYOR OF FINE YARNS

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MATERIALS

3 skeins Manos del Uruguay Franca (114 yards, 150g each) in contrasting or complimentary colors

Sample knit in colors A. Mykonos, B. Menhir, C. Natural

Size US 35, 24" or 32" circular needle (or size to obtain gauge)

Tapestry needle



GAUGE

5 stitches/ 8 rows = 4" in stockinette
stitch knit in the round, blocked

FINISHED SIZE

Cowl circumference: 42"
Width: 14"

TECHNIQUES

Knitting in the round
Knit holding two strands of yarn
together

TO BEGIN

With color A & two strands of yarn
held together, CO 55 stitches using
long tail or preferred cast-on

Place marker & join to begin knitting
in the round.

*Note: Two strands of yarn are
held together throughout pattern.
Simply pull from the inside &
outside of ball.

BEGIN PATTERN

Continue with Color A
Rounds 1-6: Purl
Rounds 7-8: Knit

Cut color A yarn

Begin knitting with Color B holding
two strands together

Rounds 9-10: Knit
Rounds 11-16: Purl
Rounds 17-18: Knit

Cut color B yarn

Begin knitting with Color C holding
two strands together

Rounds 19-20: Knit
Rounds 21-26: Purl

BIND-OFF

Bind-off stitches loosely (purling)

FINISHING

Weave in ends with tapestry needle
Spray or steam block.

Abbreviations & Notes

CO: Cast-on

K: Knit

P: Purl
