

# Stitch Sampler Cowl

by Wool & Co.

## EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Beginner

*A simple, relaxing knit that looks great with any outfit. Knit in soft, worsted weight yarn, the cowl has the perfect amount of drape & a textured stitch pattern that adds visual interest.*



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## MATERIALS

1 skein Malabrigo Rios  
(210 yards, 100g) or any other worsted weight  
yarn

Sample Yarn Color  
063 Natural

Size US 8, 24" circular needles (or size to  
obtain gauge)

Stitch marker  
Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

18 stitches = 4"

## FINISHED SIZE

28" circumference

## TECHNIQUES

Long tail cast-on  
Knitting in the round  
Increases & decreases  
Binding-off

## SET-UP

With US 8, 24" circular needle CO 128  
stitches using long tail cast-on.

Place marker, begin 2x2 ribbing, connecting to  
knit in the round.

## 2X2 RIBBING

Round 1: \*K2, P2\*

Repeat round 1 until piece measures 1.5" from  
cast-on edge.

## ALTERNATED SMOOTH STITCH & TIER

Round 1: Knit  
Round 2: Knit  
Round 3: Purl  
Round 4: Knit

Repeat rounds 1-4 two more times.

## LOOP PATTERN

Round 1: Knit  
Round 2: \*P1, S1WYIF\*  
Round 3: Knit  
Round 4: \*S1WYIF, P1\*

Repeat rounds 1-4 two more times.

## EYELETS

Round 1: Knit  
Round 2: Knit  
Round 3: \*YO, K2TOG, K2\*  
Round 4: Knit

Repeat rounds 1-4 two more times.

## 2X2 RIBBING

Round 1: \*K2, P2\*  
Repeat round 1 until piece measures 1.5"  
from cast-on edge.

## FINISHING

Bind-off all stitches in K2, P2 pattern.  
Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail.  
Weave in ends with tapestry needle.  
Spray or steam block.

## Notes

CO: Cast-on  
K: Knit  
P: Purl  
K2TOG: Knit two stitches together  
YO: Yarnover  
S1WYIF: Slip one stitch purlwise  
with yarn in front as if to purl
