

Summit Valley Cowl

EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Beginner

Chic on or off the slopes, the Summit Valley Cowl is a simple stockinette cowl that allows the yarn to shine. Soft & cozy Shibui Birch is held together with luxe Farmers Daughter Mighty Mo to add dimension to solid colors.

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PURVEYOR OF FINE YARNS

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MATERIALS

2 skeins of Shibui Birch (fingering weight) in complimentary or contrasting colors
1 skein Farmer's Daughter Mighty Mo (lace weight mohair)

Sample Yarn Colours

1 skein Shibui Birch Suit (color A)
1 skein Shibui Birch Velvet (color B)
1 skein Farmer's Daughter Mighty Mo,
Missoula Saturday Night (used throughout)

Size US 6, 24" circular needle (or size to obtain gauge)

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

21 stitches/32 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch knit in the round, blocked

FINISHED SIZE

Cowl measures 18" long x 28" circumference

TECHNIQUES

Knitting in the round

SET-UP

Cowl is knit in the round holding 1 strand of Birch with 1 strand of Mighty Mo. 2 colors of Birch are used throughout the pattern to create a subtle stripe pattern. Cowl could be knit omitting the stripes & using just 1 color of Birch (you will still need 2 skeins).

With color A held together with Mighty Mo, CO 138 stitches using long tail or preferred cast-on.

BEGIN PATTERN

Knit 32 rounds (color A + Mighty Mo)

STRIPE PATTERN 1

Cut yarn A & switch to B
Knit 6 rounds (color B + Mighty Mo)
Cut yarn B & switch to A
Knit 6 rounds (color A + Mighty Mo)
Repeat stripe pattern 2 more times

MIDDLE SECTION

Cut yarn A & switch to B
Knit 40 rounds (color B + Mighty Mo)

STRIPE PATTERN 2

Cut yarn B & switch to A
Knit 8 rounds (color A + Mighty Mo)
Cut yarn A & switch to B
Knit 8 rounds (color B + Mighty Mo)

FINAL SECTION

Cut yarn B & switch to A
Knit 32 rounds (color A + Mighty Mo)

CO: Cast-on

K: Knit
